<input type="checkbox"/> Review medications with focus of potential interactions with medication assisted treatment (MAT) ¹	<input type="checkbox"/> Determine OUD severity using DSM-5 Criteria ²	<input type="checkbox"/> Consider fetal anatomy or growth ultrasound	<input type="checkbox"/> HIV testing
<input type="checkbox"/> Assess for mental health disorders (e.g. depression)	<input type="checkbox"/> Assess withdrawal symptoms with COWS score ³		<input type="checkbox"/> Hep B and C infection testing
